

# Integrated Palliative Care in the Management of Advanced Heart Failure






#### **Introduction**

- Heart failure (HF) remains a progressive and highly symptomatic disease.
- Affects 900,000 people in the UK with 60,000 new cases yearly (1)
- Accounts for 2% of the total NHS budget (2).

## <u>Aim</u>

• To assess palliative care needs in patients admitted with advanced heart failure in a tertiary cardiology centre.





Results

• 1/3 patients had >5 hospital admissions in the preceding 2 years.

• Only 1/3 of patients had been referred to palliative care with only

Of those with an ICD, only 1 in 10 had a documented device plan

25% having an integrated palliative care plan in place.


30% had no advance care plan, DNACPR decision, and

• 29% had a documented preferred place of death (PPOD)

• Of those who died (n=80), only 18% achieved their PPOD.

### **Conclusion & Recommendations**

- Patients with advanced HF have significant physical and palliative care needs which remain largely unmet.
- We recommend an integrated heart failure-palliative care MDT be created trust-wide with referral triggers to include NHYA III & IV symptoms, complex physical and psychosocial needs.
- We recommend that integrated heart failure-palliative care be the subject of regular quality improvement strategies.
